


### MEL


### KEVINA

Please note that transportation costs are the responsibility of the buyer, though we may be able to assist with in-state (TN) transportation. All F4 ram-lambs are being sold as wethers. All sheep/lambs will be available to go to their new homes on or before June 15th, 2025.
